While we, as a privately held corporation, are not subject to the rules and reporting requirements associated with Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act (“Conflict Minerals”), we understand that our business partners may be and we are committed to helping our partners comply with their reporting requirements.

Based on EICC Conflict Minerals Report Templates obtained from our material suppliers as well as our due diligence in our supply chain, PTFE Group of Companies has determined that to the best of our knowledge our products are free of Conflict Minerals as defined by Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. This act defines Conflict Minerals as cassiterite, columbite, tantalite, gold, wolframite, or their derivatives, including tantalum, tin and tungsten, which originate from the Democratic Republic of the Congo or specified adjoining countries.
